



Pupil Premium 2016/2017

Last year, the illustrative budget was set at £100,320.00 of Pupil Premium Funding. We ensured our pupil premium money was used to sustain and provide inclusive learning opportunities and experiences throughout New Penshaw Academy, including supporting intervention where there were gaps within progress and attainment. This is something that will continue through this academic year of 2016/17, with a new budget of £96,660.00

As part of our robust and rigorous tracking and monitoring procedures, these children are tracked to ensure they are making at least the expected progress, with appropriate interventions identified in order to support and sustain this. The Pupil Premium funding was used for the following:

- Additional adult support within school to ensure pupil progress and attainment. Good quality teacher and teaching assistant support offering small group work, planned interventions and after school clubs.
- Learning resources purchased to support and enhance the curriculum. It also supported pupil motivational rewards such as cinema vouchers, football tickets and our Treasure Chest Assembly rewards.
- Educational Visits which enriched learning opportunities were subsidised, promoting aspiration, self-confidence and self-esteem. We also provided visitors linked to topics, events within school and an activity residential at Derwent Hill.

2016 attainment shows that 50% of our pupil premium children achieved the Expected Standard in Reading, Writing and Maths combined. Pupil premium children have made at least good progress across this academic year.
