What's Happening in the Classroom?

A huge welcome to our new children and a warm welcome back to the children who were with us last term. We are looking forward to getting to know you all! We hope you all had a safe and happy Easter and ready to begin some more learning.

This term the children are learning about 'Living Eggs'. We will be getting some chick eggs delivered to us on Tuesday 2nd May and will be living with us for 2 weeks. Feel free to drop in to watch them grow from 3:10-3:30pm.
