P.E

- ◆ P.E. Day for Reception children is every Wednesday morning. The PE kit is purple shorts, white t-shirt and trainers/plimsolls. These can be left on the children's pegs and taken home for washing as needed. Earrings will need to be removed or covered with a plaster.

Homework

- ◆ We have an exciting new homework system in place this term. All children will get a copy of our new homework project and are encouraged to choose one activity per week to complete. They can choose to complete more activities during each week if they wish. We will share all pieces of homework on the last Friday (26th May). There is also a points system for this!
- ◆ Could home readers be returned to school every Wednesday.
- ◆ We also love to see/hear that your child has been busy at home. If your child produces or makes anything at home e.g. pictures, stories, models etc. we would love for you to bring them into school.
