What's Happening in the Classroom?

Welcome back to all of our families, we hope you have had a relaxing Summer and are looking forward to a well-earned break. As always, we have a busy term planned for the children as they begin their final year in primary school. Our class topic for the term will be 'Terror in the Trenches' based around World War 1.

Our learning for literacy will be based around recount initially, we will be looking at the key features of the text type before writing our own War Time diary entries.

Maths will focus on fractions, decimals and percentages this half term. We will be finding decimal equivalents to fractions and converting between fractions decimals and percentages. We will also be looking adding and subtracting fractions and mixed numbers.
