



PE and Sport Grant Academic Year 2018-19

The Department of Education provides additional funding to all schools to help them improve their provision of PE and Sport for the benefit of primary aged pupils so that they develop healthy lifestyles.

New Penshaw Academy will receive **£17,440** for PE funding. We have, and are, using this funding to provide inclusive learning opportunities and experiences within PE. We have improved the quality and breadth of PE allowing accessibility and development for all.

Funding for this academic year will support:

- Employing specialist sports coaches to work alongside teachers to increase subject knowledge and skills. For example; Football coaches and multi skills sessions. This is to provide expert knowledge and understanding of required skills, games and rules.
- Employing a sports teaching assistant apprentice to work alongside the coaches and in all year groups
- Community links with comprehensive school and local primary schools. For example; competitions for children to be involved and work together in, training from expert PE teachers and opportunities to take part in a wide range of sports. All Year groups will be included in this timetable of activities.
- After school sports clubs, for example football, multi-skills.
- Transport for children to and from sporting events.
