

## **PE and Sport Grant Academic Year 2015-16**

The Department of Education is providing additional funding to all schools to help them improve their provision of PE and Sport for the benefit of primary aged pupils so that they develop healthy lifestyles.

New Penshaw Academy will receive £8,625 PE funding. We have, and are, using this funding to provide inclusive learning opportunities and experiences within PE. We have improved the quality and breadth of PE allowing accessibility and development for all.

Funding for this academic year will support:

- Employing specialist sports coaches to work alongside teachers to increase subject knowledge and skills. For example; Football coaches and multi skills sessions. This is to provide expert knowledge and understanding of required skills, games and rules.
- Community links with comprehensive school and local primary schools. For example; competitions for children to be involved and work together in, training from expert PE teachers and opportunities to take part in a wide range of sports. All Year groups will be included in this timetable of activities. Activities included are hockey, kwik cricket, tag rugby, golf, tennis, football, multi skills, skipping, dance and gymnastics.
- Staff CPD will be led by Biddick to develop assessment and development of PE. This CPD will be targeted at all staff, focusing on a year group at a time to develop skills and knowledge for challenging yet achievable learning.
- After school sports clubs, for example football, multi-skills.
- Transport for children to and from sporting events.
- We have also enriched learning opportunities using sport and healthy living as the core target. We have promoted self-confidence and self-esteem by providing inclusive whole school sports development.
